WHEN: Saturday, August 21st from 2-5PM

WHERE: Dennis Musselman's Residence, 1383 Anvick Road, Arcata CA

DIRECTIONS: from Hwy 101, exit Samoa Avenue heading east for 0.8 miles. At the circle make a right on Bayside Rd/Old Arcata Rd for 0.3 miles. Turn left on Anvick Road for 0.4 miles

PROGRAM: We will be having our annual summer barbeque/potluck. Main meat course will be provided. Bring a dish and drinks (plates, utensils & cups provided). Get to meet your fellow woodworkers and share our common enthusiasm for woodworking. Bring what you're working on (pictures or the real thing).

September 25th tour and discussion

WHEN: Saturday, September 25 starting at Noon

WHERE: Whitethorn Construction, 545 Shelter Cove Road, Whitethorn, CA

DIRECTIONS: From Eureka, drive south for about 64 miles on Hwy 101. Exit 642 toward Redway and merge right onto Redwood Drive for 1.8 miles. Turn right onto Briceland Road/Briceland Thorne Road for 5.1 miles. Veer left onto Briceland Thorne Road for 6.4 miles. Continue straight at Thorn Junction. You are now on Shelter Cove Road. White Thorn construction is .5 miles further down the road.

PROGRAM: Tour and discussion of the Whitethorn Construction Company. This locally owned business mills and sells native hardwood lumber and secondary products for local homes and business, and supports the development of other businesses the local hardwood industry by hosting workshops and participates in the [Sustainable Hardwood Network](#). By offering these services, Whitethorn helps maximize community benefits and sustainable employment opportunities from local forests, and provides incentives for local landowners to maintain a diversity of species in their forest management planning. Another Successful WoodFair

Thanks to all the hard work of our Events Coordinator, Susan Bicknell, the Liaison Team, and all the hardworking HSW volunteers, the society was able to provide the community another WoodFair. Over 1500 people attended. Don Bicknell, our treasurer, will give a full report on the finances in September, but he estimates that the society has cleared over \$2000 over expenses to be carried forward for WoodFair 2011. In addition the Scholarship Silent Auction netted \$1,140, which will allow the society to offer spring scholarships to CR woodworking students as well as for this coming fall semester. Board of Directors of the Humboldt Wildlife Care Center, whose volunteers catered the affair, Sent us a Thank You card. The monies they made will help them greatly to continue their mission to provide medical care for injured wildlife in our community.
