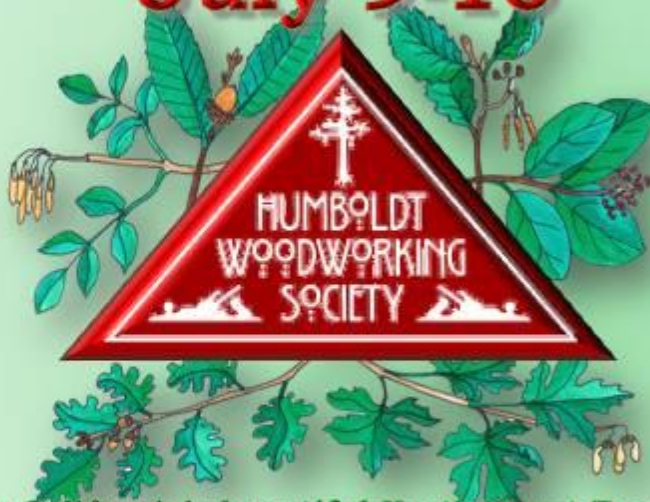

### JURIED EXHIBITION

Woodworkers of all ages are invited to submit your best works for the largest and most prestigious woodworking exhibition in Northern California. Review the judging criteria at [www.HumboldtWoodFair.org](http://www.HumboldtWoodFair.org).

Grand Prizes of \$500 each will be awarded for:

- Best of Show
- Most Creative
- Best Woodworking with Local Hardwoods (“Local Hardwoods” is defined to include native woods from northern California and southern Oregon, as well as urban lumber salvaged from our regional cities and towns.)

Competition will occur in three divisions:

- Novice Division with First (\$250), Second (\$200), and Third (\$150). Open to enthusiasts of all ages who are honing their skills and are new to design but have had **less than one year** of formal training in fine woodworking at the collegiate level. High school students are particularly encouraged to enter.
- Fine Woodworker Division with First (\$250), Second (\$200), and Third (\$150) prizes in each of the following categories:
  - Fine Furniture
  - Cabinetry and Casework
  - Woodturning
  - Sculpture, and Carving
  - All Other (musical instruments, jigs and shop fixtures, intarsia, marquetry, boats, small projects, models, millwork, etc.)
- Master Division with First, Second, and Third Place Recognition Awards

### VENDOR INFORMATION

Vendors will be selected for participation in WoodFair 2011 based on two criteria: First, wood must be the predominant characteristic of products and activities of your display, and second, products and setup of your display must be of high quality. As you design your display remember that it must be free standing. Anchoring of any objects to the floor or walls is prohibited. Plan your time so that you or your representative(s) are present both days of the event all hours it is open. Vendors who will not be bringing their own may reserve chairs and tables for a small fee. In addition, fee-paying Vendors may enter items in the exhibition at half price. Free table space is available for woodworking related nonprofits and school groups wishing to promote their programs.

Vendors are required to provide a certificate of liability insurance naming WoodFair, Almquist Lumber Company, and Humboldt Woodworking Society as additional insureds with their entry form, OR an additional fee of \$50 to cover group vendor liability insurance. All vendors must fill out and sign the attached “hold harmless agreement.”

## WOODFAIR ENTRY PROCEDURE

1. Complete and sign this entry form
2. Attach photo(s) of your juried show entry or booth and products
3. Vendors attach signed Hold Harmless Agreement AND either a Certificate of Insurance or a fee for \$50.

Neither Almquist Lumber nor Humboldt Woodworking Society take commissions or participate in sales of vendor products or exhibition works. Almquist Lumber and Humboldt Woodworking Society assume no responsibility for works damaged, broken or lost while on the premises, damages to works while in transit to the premises, or pieces left beyond the specified pickup date. Submission to WoodFair grants Almquist Lumber and Humboldt Woodworking Society the right to photograph exhibited works and vendor booths and products, and use submitted photos for publicity and educational purposes. We reserve the right to decline exhibition works and vendor participation that, after arriving, differ greatly from the entry description and photo or do not meet the stated criteria. Photos will not be returned. There will be no refunds for cancellations.

**Hold Harmless Agreement**  
**WoodFair 2011**  
**Concessionaires (Vendors) and Other Service Providers**

\_\_\_\_\_ (Concessionaire) shall, at its own and sole expense:

(a) Maintain at all times while performing under this agreement, the insurance coverage set forth below with insurers satisfactory to **Humboldt Woodworking Society and Alquist Lumber Company (including their officers, directors, employees, agents, owners, and/or volunteers) (hereinafter "WoodFair")** for policy limits not less than the amounts stated below:

- 1) Workers' Compensation Insurance as required by the laws and regulations applicable to and covering employees of Concessionaire engaged in the performance of work under this agreement.
- 2) Commercial General Liability (CGL) (or Public Liability) insurance with limits of liability of not less than: Bodily Injury -- \$1 million (\$1,000,000) each person per occurrence/aggregate; Property Damage -- \$1 million (\$1,000,000) per occurrence/aggregate limits. This policy shall cover, among other risks, the contractual liability assumed by Concessionaire under the indemnification provision set forth in this agreement, personal injury coverage, premises liability coverage and advertising injury coverage with limits of liability identical to coverage for Bodily Injury as stated above.
- 3) Automobile Liability insurance, including non-owned and hired vehicle coverage with limits of liability of not less than \$1 million (\$1,000,000) combined single limit per occurrence and in the aggregate.

NOTE: *Nothing contained in these provisions relating to insurance coverage and amounts set herein shall operate as a limitation of Concessionaire's liability.*

(b) Deliver to organization prior to commencement of the event a certificate of insurance which shall:

- 1) Evidence the above coverages including: the identity of the insurer(s), the policy number(s), the effective dates of coverage and the limits of liability.
- 2) Name WoodFair including Alquist Lumber Company and Humboldt Woodworking Society (and all their officers, directors, members, employees, owners, agents, and volunteers) as additional insureds for the duration of WoodFair, July 8 - 10, 2011.

NOTE: *Failure of Concessionaire to keep the required insurance policies in full force and effect during the work covered by this agreement shall constitute a breach of this agreement. In the event of a breach, WoodFair shall have the right, in addition to any other rights, to immediately cancel and terminate participation of vendor in WoodFair and this agreement without further cost to WoodFair by notifying Concessionaire in writing of such cancellation and termination.*

(c) If a person, entity, or organization makes a claim against WoodFair and WoodFair is or may be liable for loss or damage sustained by the person, entity or organization, immediately upon WoodFair's written request, Concessionaire will take all steps necessary, including hiring counsel, to defend, protect, indemnify, hold harmless and render whole WoodFair against any and all claims, demands, suits or causes of action brought against WoodFair for all liability, damage or loss, whether sought under law or in equity, which may be asserted against WoodFair. The obligation undertaken by Concessionaire in this paragraph arises if the claims made against WoodFair are on account of injury, loss or damage caused by, arising out of, or in any way incidental to the conduct or operation of Concessionaire.

WoodFair and Concessionaire agree that the obligations under this agreement include, but are not limited to, those situations where liability for (1) injury, loss or damage is caused by the combined or concurrent negligence of WoodFair, Concessionaire or any third party ( and any of their respective officers, directors, employees, agents and/or volunteers; and/or (2) injury, loss, or damage arises with or without fault based on any theory of strict liability, statutory liability or by operation of law.

WoodFair and Concessionaire agree that to the extent this indemnification of WoodFair for injury, loss or damage may be found to be contrary to existing or newly-enacted law, this provision, to such extent (and only such extent), is and shall be void or voidable. In such instance, Concessionaire agrees to immediately defend, indemnify, save and hold WoodFair harmless to the fullest extent allowed by law.
